

Report on Second General Meeting Bilbao, Spain

As part of the Tuning India project, Dr.Raakhi Gupta, Registrar, the IIS (deemed to be UNIVERSITY) and Dr.Sanjay Kedia, Assistant Professor, participated in the Second General Meeting held at University of Deusto, Spain, during November 19-23, 2018.

The objective of the meeting, attended by 35 representatives from different partner universities of India and other universities from European Union countries of Spain, Ireland, Belgium, Netherlands, Italy, was to discuss the activities conducted during the previous six months under the project at the University level and to plan for the next six months. The design of the meeting included plenary session, open discussions, group work and presentations.

Discussions focused on Generic Competencies, Survey Results from Subject Specific Competencies, Case studies on creation of meta-profiles of different academic programmes, Objectives and outcomes of the second general meeting, Tasks to be completed before the third meeting, Practical aspects and running of the project, and Research in Tuning.

The participants worked in groups and created meta profiles by combing generic and subject specific competencies. The first draft of the meta profile including definition of the area, generic and subject specific competencies was finalised. The Subject Area Group Coordinators presented the first draft of the subject area meta profile. This was followed by a sharing of experiences by the members of Tuning Africa and Tuning India.

In the last session on the last day, the Managing Editor of the Tuning Journal for Higher Education presented the Research included in the Tuning Journal.
