A 15 day Nukkad Natak workshop was organized from August 2, 2017. A total of 24 students participated in it. The resource person was Ms. Ruchi Bhargava, a theatre trainer and dancer.

The workshop focused on short plays like nukkad natak is a form of theatrical performance and presentation in outdoor public spaces without a specific paying audience. These spaces can be anywhere, including shopping centres, car parks, recreational reserves, college or university campus and street corners. They are especially seen in outdoor spaces where there are large numbers of people. The logistics of doing street theatre necessitate simple costumes and props, and often there is little or no amplification of sound, with actors depending on their natural vocal and physical ability. The performances need to be highly visible, loud and simple to follow in order to attract a crowd.

The students got to learn many new parameters of short plays.





Students performed Nukkad on 14th August, 2017 at 12:00 to 12.15 on the topic “Marital Rape” which was an outcome of a workshop organized from 2-13August, 2017 whose resource person was Ms. Ruchi Bhargava.

The play explained the lack of consent is the essential element and need not involve physical violence. Marital rape is considered a form of domestic violence and sexual abuse. The issues of sexual and domestic violence within marriage and the family unit, and more specifically, the issue of violence against women, have come to growing international attention from the second half of the 20th century. Still, in many countries, marital rape either remains outside the criminal law, or is illegal but widely tolerated. Laws are rarely being enforced, due to factors ranging from reluctance of authorities to pursue the crime, to lack of public knowledge that sexual intercourse in marriage without consent is illegal.

The IISU Theatrical Societies Annual Play workshop commenced on 22nd August 2017 under the supervision of Mr Hardik Shah. This year the theme of the annual play was Persian with environmental stage.

Persian theatre became popular in Iran in 7th century AD, long before the advent of cinema. Few of the well known Parsi Plays are - Ru Howzi (comical acts on domestic life), Pardeh Dari (screen based storytelling), Pardeh-khaani (mobile singing, storytelling read off a curtain).

The Parsi play shortlisted for the year 2017 was *Rustom O Sohrab*, an Urdu play by Agha Hashar Kashmiri. The tragedy of **Rostam and Sohrab** forms part of the 10th-century Persian epic Shahnameh by the Persian poet Ferdowsi. It tells the tragic story of the heroes Rostam and his son, Sohrab. It was first published in 1929.



The whole process of making this play was larger than life. With team of more than 26 actors(students) the practice of the play started with vigorous training in sword fighting, voice modulation exercise, music class, script reading, set designing, allocation of

different props, lights and gym workout, Every step include learning, hardwork, dedication, determination, conviction and management for completing each task perfectly. From beginning team was been divided into different departments like set designing, costume, museum, props, stage managers etc. In short the creation of the whole play involved a process informed by method, aesthetic choice and economic context, as well as practical aspects.

A Guest Lecture on the topic “ History of Parsi Plays” was organized Back Stage on August 24, 2017 for the students. Mr. Ranbeer Sing, National Head, Indian Peoples Theatre was the speaker for the day. Venue was Stage and timing 9.30AM to 1:00 PM. Mr. Sigh is presently the president of Indian People’s Theatre Association, India. He’s also the founder of Jaipur Theatre Group.



He started the orientation by taking the students for a long historical journey of theatre. He portrayed the hierarchy from Sanskrit Theatre as the ancestor to Persian Theatre and that to the present day theatre in the most exquisite manner. In context with the play, “Rustam- O- Sohrab” he told that it was the first Persian play written by Amateur theatre company in 1929. The company never knew that the Persian Theatre could turn into a

professional theatre. The writer, Agha Hashar Kashmiri was initially a shawl seller and after watching a play, he had an instinct of writing a play himself. Hence, he wrote Rustam- O – Sohrab in Hindustani language. Agha Hashar is called the The Shakespeare of India. Throwing some more light upon Persian theatre, “There’s no sense of Persian theatre if you can't sing” said Mr. Sigh. Also that the art of adaptation is a gift of Persian theatre only. He concluded the session by wishing students all the very best for their upcoming production as it's not an impossible task but a tough one indeed. It'll require a lot of stamina, hard work and dedication.

Persian theatre became popular in Iran in 7th century AD, long before the advent of cinema. Few of the well known Parsi Plays are - Ru Howzi (comical acts on domestic life), Pardeh Dari (screen based storytelling), Pardeh-khaani (mobile singing, storytelling read off a curtain).

The Parsi play shortlisted for the year 2017 was *Rustom O Sohrab*, an Urdu play by Agha Hashar Kashmiri. The tragedy of **Rostam and Sohrab** forms part of the 10th-century Persian epic Shahnameh by the Persian poet Ferdowsi. It tells the tragic story of the heroes Rostam and his son, Sohrab. It was first published in 1929.

The whole process of making this play was larger than life. He comes to Samangan: a territory under Iran's biggest foe, Turan, in search of his horse Rakhsh. Samangan's princess Tehmina is well aware of Rustom's name and reputation. Tehmina and Rustom fall in love with each other but Rustom has to go back to his country on call of duty for the nation. For 16 years, Rustom and Tehmina spend a life without any contact. The only evidence of their togetherness is Sohrab, their son, of whose existence Rustom remains unaware till the end. Rustom and Sohrab are brought face to face for the first time in life, on a battlefield. Even the enemies are unaware of their relationship. 

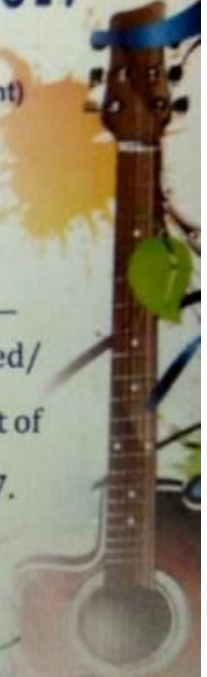


